Monday 9th February, 2004

Family Law

looks in depth at the significance of the law in the lives of clients, using case examples. (whole day)

Tuesday 10th February, 2004

Shared Parenting (am)

examines the principle and looks at its implications for staff working with families. (half day)

GLASGOW

Monday 15th March, 2004

Relationships, Separation & Divorce

enables participants to use their experience to explore what these concepts mean and to look at how they relate to practice. (whole day)

Tuesday 16th March, 2004

Money (am)

gives a non-expert overview of benefits, the Tax Credit system and their implications for families.

Working with Fathers (pm)

looks at the role and stereotyping of fathers, examining what issues fathers have and what works with them. (half days)
